
Psychology in NSW: An Overview



Assessment and Selection (A&S)

- A&S efforts utilize specialized psychological assessment capabilities to support leadership's selection and development of NSW personnel.
- It is based on a well-established, gold standard process utilized across the DOD, IC, and Corporate America to select the *right* person for the right job at the right time.
- A&S programs utilize psychological principles to identify human factors related to:
 - ✓ Job suitability
 - ✓ Organizational risk
 - ✓ Fit
- A&S programs can identify, predict, and enhance attributes that contribute to mission success (both selection and development).

Force Optimization

- "Humans are more important than hardware"
- The goal is to get to the Left of Bang:
 - ✓ Keep warriors in the fight
 - ✓ Optimize performance and mission success
 - ✓ Connect to the most relevant resources early and often



- - Everyone gets it, non-medical encounters & education, no big deal but can identify potential problems before they develop
 - > Every engine needs an oil change on the regular. Don't wait until your engine blows up to take your car in.
- ✓ Executive Coaching, education, training, feedback, & consultation



Clinical Intervention / Support

- Although the goals for NSW are prevention, health promotion, and force optimization, this job can take a toll on Operators.
- Embedded providers (active duty, CIV, contractor) offer treatment modalities to address multiple psychological injuries and conditions (TBI, PTSD/Combat Operational Stress, grief, family stress) that is:
 - ✓ Culturally competent
 - ✓ Individually tailored
 - ✓ Evidence-based
 - ✓ Timely and proximal access to care
- Collaboration and coordination with our military and civilian partners to meet the needs, overcome barriers, and fill in the gaps and seams
